She has worked as a government relations liaison, director of advocacy, parent consultant, attorney, and trainer. She has presented and written on such topics as early hearing detection and intervention, education, test equity, civil rights, family support, deaf-hearing partnerships, and parent and deaf community involvement and has testified before Congress. The parent of two deaf children, Dr. Raimondo has served as a board member for the American Society for Deaf Children, where she was presented with their Lee Katz Award for "dedication and service to families raising children who are deaf or hard of hearing." She also has served on the board of the Maryland School for the Deaf, including three terms as president.
